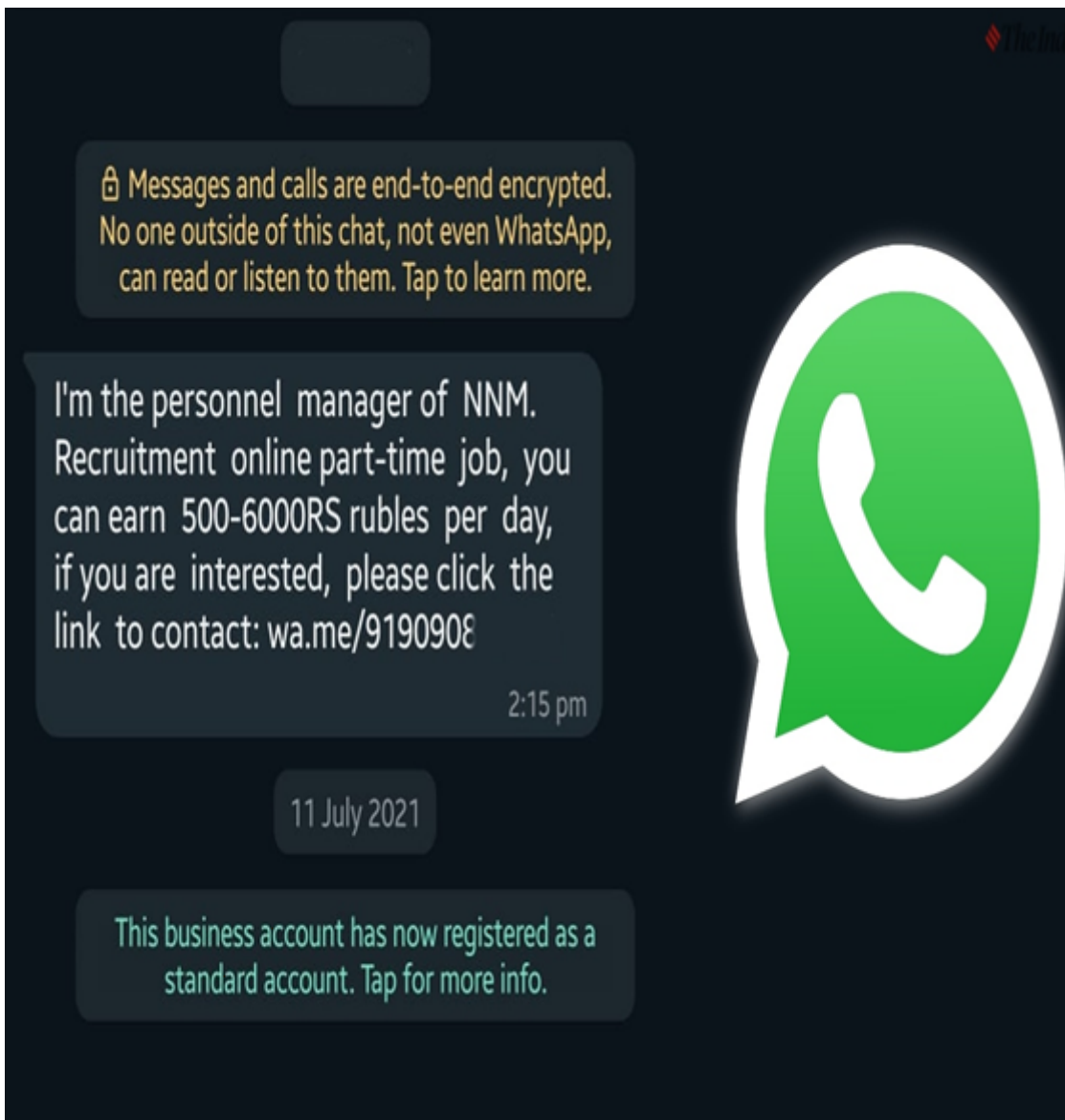

The "Photo Trap"

A photo trap is when someone asks for your photo - even a seemingly innocent one - and then misuse it in harmful ways.

- **Step 1: Build Trust**

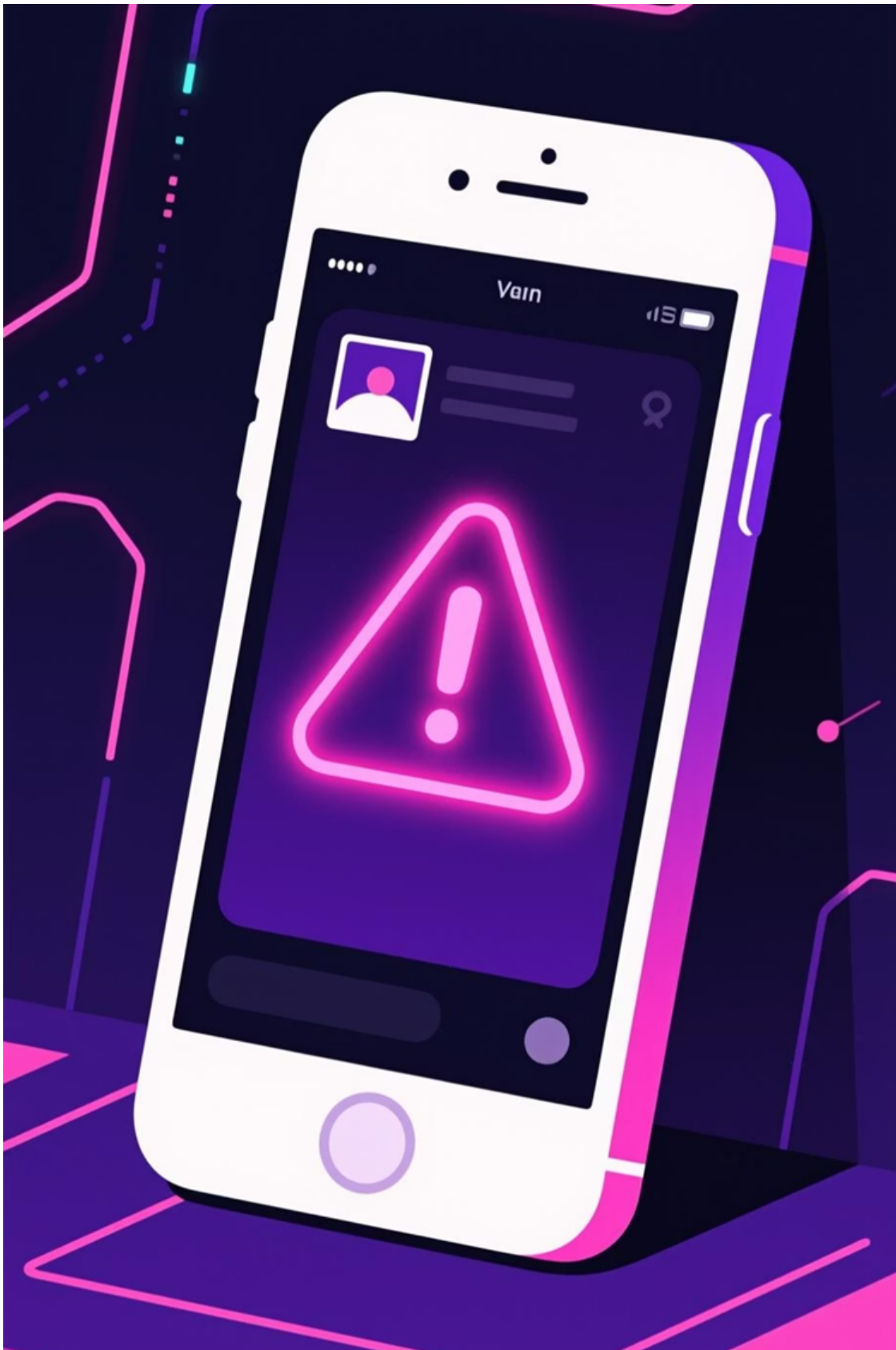
A new online friend starts chatting and build relationship with you over time.

- **Step 2: The ask**

They ask for a simple photo, making it seem casual or harmless

- **Step 3: The Trap**

They use it to blackmail you, create fake profiles , or share it publically without your permission.



Critical Rule: Once you send a photo, you lose control over it forever. It can be copied, edited, and shared without your consent.

How To Avoid Photo Traps: The 3 Rules

- **Stop:** Pause before you post or send anything. Ask yourself: "Why do they need this photo? Does this request feel right?"
- **Scrub:** Check the photo carefully for the identity details like your school uniform, house number, street sign, or location tags.
- **Share Smartly:** Only share photo with people you know in real life and genuinely trust. Online only friends don't count.

When in doubt, don't send it out!



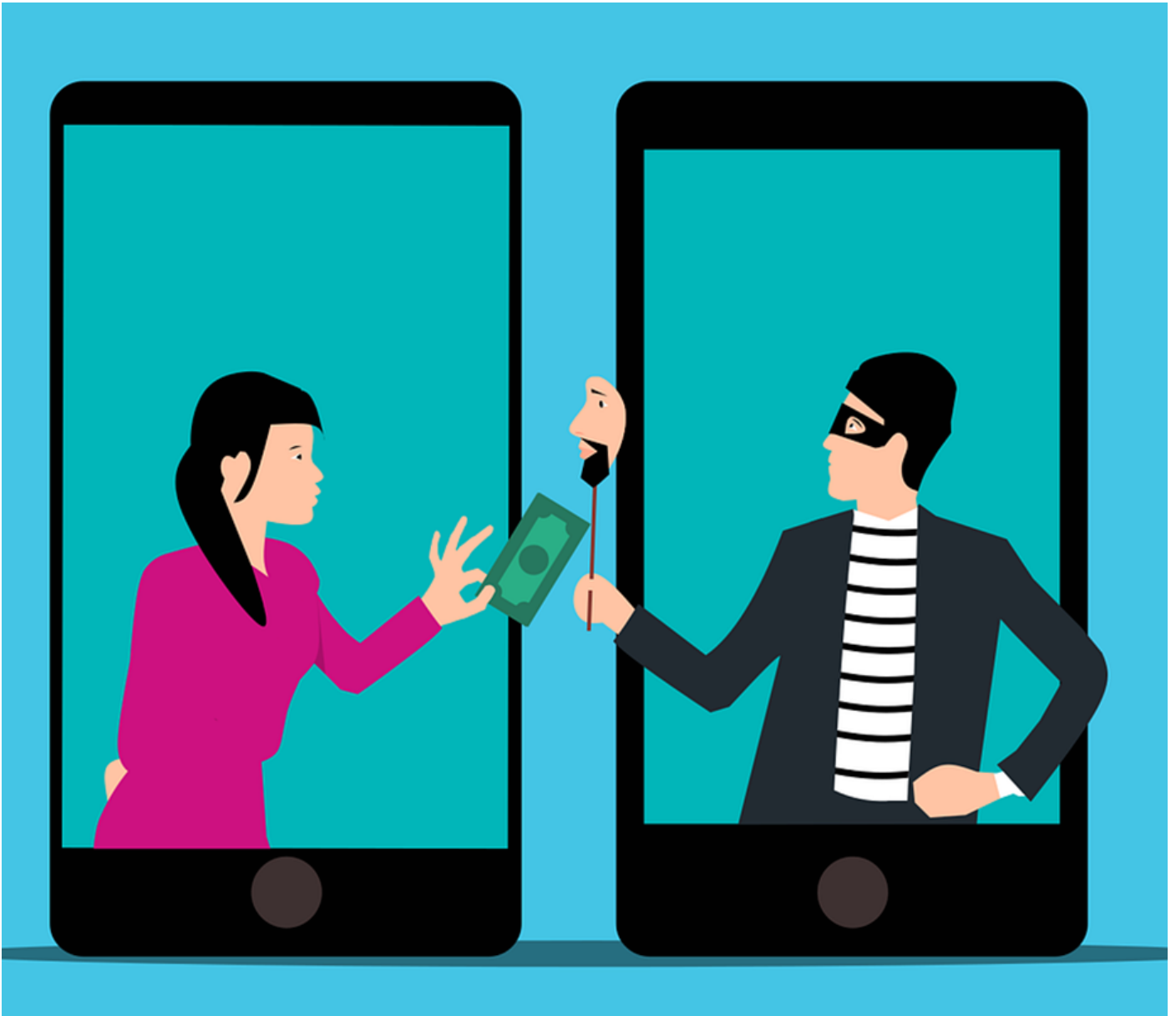

What is "Digital Arrest"?

Digital police is a dangerous scam where fraudsters pretend to be police officers, government officials, or law enforcement agents.

Here's how it works:

- They contact you claiming you've committed a serious crime.
- They demand immediate payment to avoid arrest or legal action.
- They may try to isolate you from friends and family.
- They create panic to pressure you into quick decisions.

What is Digital Footprint?

Your digital footprint is your online story - the trail of data you leave behind as you navigate the internet. It's created by everything you do in the digital world:

- Posts, likes, and shares on social media.
- Photos and videos where you're tagged.
- Comments you make on websites or apps.
- Search history and website visits

Key message: This story is PUBLIC and often PERMANENT. What you post today can be discovered years from now.

Why Your Digital Footprints Matters?



- **Future You:** Over 70% of colleges and employers check social media profiles before making decisions. Your digital footprints can open doors or close them.



- **Your Reputation:** Your online presence shapes what people think about you - friends, teachers, and future connections all form an impression based on what they see.



- **Your Safety:** Personal information you share online can reveal where you live, go to school, or spend time - putting your privacy and safety at risk.



- **It Can Be Used Against You:** Posted content can be weaponized for cyberbullying, identity theft, or fraud by people with bad intentions.
